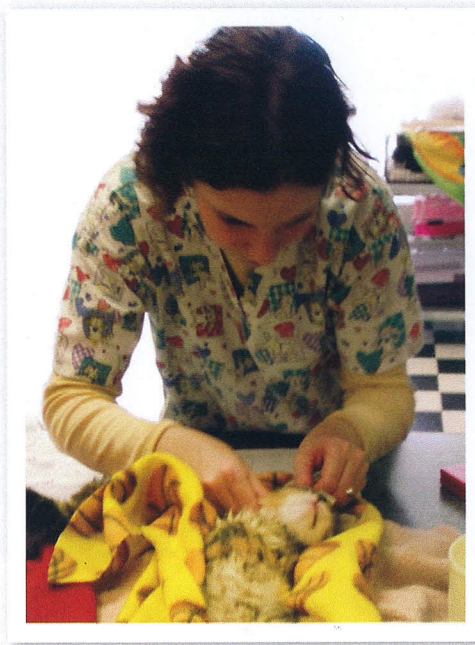


TRUTH IN NUMBERS

- » There are an estimated **1.2 MILLION** homeless cats in the Puget Sound region.
- » Cats are prolific breeders. The average adult female can produce up to **3 LITTERS** or approximately **12 KITTENS** per year. Within a few years, a single breeding feline can result in a colony of over **100 CATS**.
- » Throughout Washington, **TENS OF THOUSANDS** of cats are surrendered to our community shelters each year. Due to over population, a large percentage are euthanized.
- » We alter up to **50** cats per day and will soon reach a milestone of **100,000** surgeries. Our work has kept **MORE THAN A MILLION KITTENS** from being born into feline homelessness.

The Feral Cat Spay/Neuter Project provides spay and neuter services for **all cats** with an emphasis on the most vulnerable cats — commonly described as: feral, stray, free-roaming or homeless.

As a National Mentoring Organization, we developed a website where like-minded organizations learn to replicate our successful spay/neuter clinic model in communities across the country and around the world.

HOW DOES THE FERAL CAT SPAY/NEUTER PROJECT WORK?

Feral and free-roaming cats

We offer **free** spay/neuter services for free-roaming cats in a safe, high quality, humane environment. Cats receive a basic health exam, rabies vaccination and spay/neuter surgery. Each cat is ear tipped to show it has been altered in order to avoid future trapping/transport. All of these services are free of charge.

Adoptable and pet cats

Unaltered tame cats are the original source of most free-roaming cats, so we offer spay/neuter services without ear tipping for adoptable and pet cats. We request a small donation to help offset our costs.
